You can use a single remote with DirecTV RC73, which lets you control all devices in your home entertainment system. This feature makes things more convenient, and it's definitely worth taking advantage of. If you don't have multiple remotes, you can program your existing remote to work with new TVs or other devices. To get the most out of your DirecTV RC73, you need to pair it with each device individually. You have two options: use the automatic CodeFinder feature or enter the code manually. Both the standard universal remote and the Genie remote are programmable and can be used to control both the receiver and TV. The Genie remote is a more compact option compared to the long, white universal remote. It's compatible with any DirecTV receivers made after 2003 and comes in three different models: RC71, RC72, and RC73. The model number ending in "H" indicates that it's a hotel remote, which won't work with residential entertainment setups. To program your Genie remote to a sound bar or other audio device, follow these steps: 1. Turn on the TV and make sure the device is powered off. 2. Point the remote at your Genie receiver and press MUTE and ENTER simultaneously. 3. Release the buttons when the green light flashes twice. 4. The TV should display "Applying IR/RF setup." 5. Power on the audio device, select settings, remote control, program remote, and follow the on-screen instructions to finish. Alternatively, you can manually pair the remote with your audio device by: 1. Ensuring the TV is powered on and the audio device is off. 2. Pointing the remote at your Genie receiver and pressing MUTE and SELECT until the green light blinks twice. 3. Entering the code 961 into the remote, then press channel up. 4. Press ENTER (not SELECT). 5. Press OK when the TV displays "Your remote is now set up for RF." 6. Power on your audio device, go to settings, and you're done. To program your DIRECTV remote to control a TV, follow these steps: 1. Ensure the TV is turned off and the receiver is on. 2. Press and hold the MUTE and ENTER buttons until the green light flashes twice. 3. The TV screen will display "Applying IR/RF setup." 4. Turn on the TV. 5. Press and hold the MUTE and SELECT buttons until the green light flashes twice. 6. Enter your TV manufacturer's 5-digit code (available through a code lookup tool). 7. Alternatively, you can program the remote manually by following these steps: a. Point the remote at the receiver and press MUTE and SELECT until the green light blinks. b. Press: 961 c. Press CHANNEL UP d. Press ENTER e. When prompted, press OK to confirm the setup is complete. f. Turn on the device you want to program/pair with the remote. g. Go to Settings & Help → Settings → Remote Control → Program Remote and follow the on-screen instructions. Note: The text also provides a list of common TV manufacturers and their corresponding 5-digit codes for programming your DIRECTV RC73 remote using the TV's specific code. To program your DIRECTV remote for TV/DVD player combos, start with automatic programming and see if that works. If not, find the device's programming code or consult online tools. You can also program an old DIRECTV universal remote to control basic TV functions without a receiver. To do so: 1. Press MUTE and SELECT simultaneously until the green light flashes twice. 2. Enter the code 991 and wait for two more flashes. 3. Press 1, then pause briefly before pressing CHANNEL UP again. 4. Continue slowly pressing CHANNEL UP until the TV turns OFF. 5. Press SELECT once you've completed these steps. This should enable your remote to control the TV's power, volume, and channel selection buttons. If your remote is malfunctioning or you're using a secondhand one, resetting it may be necessary. To reset your Genie remote: To reset your DIRECTV remote, follow these steps: Locate the RESET button on the receiver or access card door and press it. Wait for at least 15 seconds. If you don't have a RESET button, try unplugging the receiver from the wall outlet for 15 seconds, then plug it back in and wait for everything to reload. Alternatively, press and hold MUTE and SELECT until the green light blinks twice, then enter 981. You can also put your remote in RF mode without using the DVR or receiver. To do this, slide the MODE switch to DIRECTV, press and hold MUTE and SELECT until you see the green light blink twice, enter 961, then press CHANNEL UP, and finally enter 347379 and SELECT. Programming your DIRECTV remote can be challenging, but it's a simple procedure that enables control of different devices from a single remote. To program your remote, follow these steps: Press the Menu button on your universal remote, then choose Parental Favs & Setup > System Setup > Remote > Program Remote. Select the device you want to program the remote for from the list, or search and enter the DIRECTV Remote code if your device isn't listed. Follow the on-screen commands to complete the process. You can use these exact steps to program the DIRECTV universal remote for both SD and HD receivers. To change the TV input source with the DIRECTV Universal remote, slide the MODE switch to the desired position. To program a DIRECTV Genie remote to work with your TV, follow these steps: 1. Hold down the Mute and Select buttons on the remote at the same time until the green light flashes twice. 2. Enter the code "960" using the remote's numeric keypad. 3. Release the buttons when the green light flashes again. 4. Slide the Mode Switch to the DIRECTV logo. If you have a Spectrum TV Gold package, you can check out the channel lineup and prices. For the automatic pairing process: 1. Point the Genie remote at your Genie HD DVR, Genie Mini, or Wireless Genie Mini. 2. Hold down the Mute and Enter buttons until the green light blinks twice. 3. Your TV should display "Applying IR/RF Setup." 4. Turn on the device you're pairing the remote with. 5. Press Menu on the remote. 6. Choose Settings & Help > Settings > Remote Control > Program Remote, and follow the on-screen instructions. If this method doesn't work for you, you can also try programming your DIRECTV Genie remote manually: 1. Point the Genie remote at your Genie HD DVR, Genie Mini, or Wireless Genie Mini. 2. Hold down the Mute and Select buttons until the green light blinks twice. 3. Enter the code "961." 4. Press the Channel Up button. 5. Press Enter. 6. Your TV should display "Your Remote is now set up for RF." 7. Select OK. 8. Turn on the device you want to pair the remote with. 9. Press Menu on the remote and select Settings & Help > Settings > Remote Control > Program Remote, then follow the on-screen steps. Finally, if you have a DIRECTV-Ready TV connected to your Genie DVR, follow these additional steps: 1. Aim the remote at your Genie DVR. 2. Press and hold Mute and Enter buttons until the green light blinks twice. 3. Turn on your DIRECTV-Ready TV. 4. Follow the same steps as above for programming the remote manually. That's it! You now know how to program your DIRECTV Genie remote to work with your TV, DVR receiver, or DIRECTV-Ready TV. Setup your DIRECTV Ready TV by first selecting the buttons on the remote control. Wait until the green lights blink again and enter the Manufacturer's code. For Samsung TVs, use 54000, for Sony TVs use 54001, and for Toshiba TVs use 54002. If you have another brand of TV, check the DIRECTV website for your specific code. Once paired, your remote will work smoothly. You can also enable voice activation using Google Assistant on the Gemini Voice remote. Tap the Google Assistant/MIC button to start speaking commands such as changing channels or seeking shows. If you need to pair a new device with your Gemini equipment, tap and hold the DASH (+) and Apps buttons until the LED blinks blue. Then, resume the Gemini device by clicking and holding FAST FORWARD and REWIND on the remote until they combine. For additional devices like TVs or soundbars, go to Settings > System > Remote & Devices > Program Your Remote and follow the instructions to choose your device brand. You can also personalize your experience by logging into your Google Account during setup for customized preferences. If your remote becomes unresponsive, try canceling and reinserting the batteries or replacing them with fresh ones.
